Coachella Valley, has held many public meetings to get input from its citizenry on how to cut the current budget after a drop in sales and property tax revenue and the loss of Redevelopment funds that cities had to give back to the State.

During the Cathedral City Council meeting on June 27, 2012, it was reported that 35 net layoffs are contemplated but that reasonable levels of service will be maintained. The Council voted to extend the current budget for a month while budget talks continue. No plans have changed regarding the potential annexation of Thousand Palms. The feasibility study is still ongoing.




MEET YOUR THOUSAND PALMS CHAMBER DIRECTORS AND AMBASSADORS MICHAEL ASCANI


